Plus de 4000 Casques bleus ont perdu la vie en servant sous le drapeau des Nations Unies.

Le 29 mai est reconnu comme journée internationale des soldats de la paix, et vise à honorer la mémoire de ceux qui ont perdu la vie au service de la paix, et à rendre hommage à tous ceux, hommes et femmes, qui ont servi et continuent de servir dans les opérations de maintien de la paix de l'ONU pour leur professionnalisme, leur dévouement et leur courage.

75th anniversary of the UN Peacekeepers

Since 1948, more than one million peacekeepers, men and women, have served the cause of the United Nations. They are soldiers, police and civilians.
More than 4,000 Blue Helmets have lost their lives serving under the United Nations flag.

May 29th is recognized as the International Day of Peacekeepers, and aims to honor the memory of those who have lost their lives in the service of peace, and to pay tribute to all those, men and women, who have served and continue to serve in UN peacekeeping operations for their professionalism, dedication and courage.


As part of its themed activities, the CSSD is initiating a challenge for this 75th anniversary, namely
